This function allows users to generate and transmit permissible prescriptions electronically to a patient's pharmacy. Additionally drug interaction, allergy checks, formulary checks, and medication lists and orders are provided with Dr.First.	Annual or monthly service fees per location per license are required to keep Practice Director updated to the most recent version. These fees are outlined in the purchase agreement annual per provider fees for DrFirst e-Prescribe are required.	No contractual limitations.	Proper initial configuration required of provider and Practice Director support to enable data communication between DrFirst and Practice Director.
Direct Messaging with Surescripts allows Transmit to 3rd Party, and Transition of Care) relevant certification criteria 170.315(b)(1), (b)(2), (h)(1).	Surescripts allows users to send and receive Direct based messages to/from other doctors. Direct messages may include clinical data including patient health information and notes. No contractual limitations.	Proper initial configuration required of provider and support to enable data communication between Surescripts and Practice Director.
Patient and Provider Portal for Secure Messaging and VDT. Relevant Certification Criteria 170.315 (e)(2), (e)(1).	Patient and Provider Portal allow patient and provider to securely message each other. Patient medical information is pushed to Portal where the patient can view, download or transmit the information.	Annual or monthly service fees per location per license are required to keep Practice Director updated to the most recent version. These fees are outlined in the purchase agreement.	No contractual limitations.	Patient and Provider Portal must be activated Practice Director.
Application Access relevant certification criteria 170.315 (g)(7), (g)(8), (g)(9)	Provides API level access to patient health information, including CCDA, using the Fast Healthcare Interoperability Resources (FHIR) standard	Annual or monthly service fees per location per license are required to keep Practice Director updated to the most recent version. These fees are outlined in the purchase agreement.	No contractual limitations.	Patient or Provider must have Patient Portal account for verifying identity and granting access to API
